



## **PARK RULES**

**ALCOHOL:** May be consumed responsibly and in moderation by adults on your site.

**AMENITIES:** Children must always be accompanied and supervised by a responsible adult.

**BEHAVIOUR:** Excessive noise, unruly behaviour, drunkenness or bad language is not tolerated in our park. Offenders will be asked to leave the park. Visitors staying with you are your responsibility; please ensure they are aware of the park rules.

**CARE:** Care must be taken of your own possessions. Your property is your responsibility. Owners and management take no responsibility for theft or damage. Please lock away valuables at night.

**DAY VISITORS:** All visitors are to report to the office on arrive before going to your site. All visitors' cars are to be parked in the visitor car park or out the front of Bindaree.

**FIRES:** The statutory Bush Fire Danger Period runs from 1 October to 31 March, unless otherwise extended. During this time lighting of campfires are not permitted within the park. Outside of this period fires are allowed only in permitted fire drums and must be at least 450mm above the ground unless a total fire ban has been declared by authorities or park owners. Use of fires may be revoked by management at any time.

**FIRE HOSES:** Are for the use of an emergency only.

**HARD RUBBISH:** All hard rubbish must be taken to the local council tip. Please do not put into skip bins.

**JUMPING PILLOW:** Jumping pillow may be closed during certain hours and when it is wet. Please take care when jumping. Guests use the Jumping Pillow at their own risk.

**MOTOR VEHICLES:** Only one car per site is permitted unless an arrangement has been agreed to by the park owners. Electric or motorised scooters, bikes, segways and golf carts are not permitted in the park.

**NOISE:** In consideration of other park users, we ask that noise be kept to a minimum after 10pm. Music curfew is 10:30pm.

**OVERNIGHT VISITORS:** Please inform the park if you have visitors coming to stay prior to arrival. Visitors are to register on arrival, at which time, overnight fees are to be paid in advance.

**PETS:** Pets are welcome in the park during off peak periods with management permission. A maximum of two dogs are permitted per site at any one time. Whilst pets are welcome in the park they are only permitted on annual sites and camping sites only. They must always be on a lead and

all waste disposed of promptly and appropriately. They are not permitted in pool area or the recreation room.

**POOL:** Pool hours are 8:30am - 8:30pm. Pool rules are to be followed. Pool hours are at the discretion of the park owners, depending on weather conditions.

**REGISTRATION:** All annual site holders must register at the office on arrival for insurance, OH&S and park fire management plan in case an emergency occurs. Please check when your visitors arrive that they have registered. Responsibility for payment of visitor's fees lies with the annual site holder.

**RUBBISH AND RECYCLING:** All rubbish bins provided by the park are for general waste only. There are bins located throughout the park specifically for recyclable cans and bottles.

**SMOKING:** No smoking in any common area or shared building in the park (pool, playground, toilets, laundry and recreation room).

**SPEED LIMIT AND SAFETY:** In the interest of safety a 10kph speed limit applies to all vehicles in the park. Push bikes must not be ridden around the amenities block or in the park after sunset and helmets must always be worn. These are important safety regulations and we ask for your assistance in adhering to them.

**PLEASE NOTE:** *All vehicles, boats and other property belonging to guests are brought in to Bindaree Holiday Park at the Owners risk. No responsibility will be taken by the Park Management for any damage or loss which may occur to such property whilst within the park.*
